Europe

Some students will be returning home during the summer to visit family.

- A SENT team from Grace Memorial Baptist will travel to the DR to serve alongside Kathryn Scott and CBM partner IBAREDO. (June 20-30)

MENA

- Please pray for the upcoming healing gathering for three pastors who recently lost their brothers in the Egyptian Baptist Convention. Ask the Lord to bring deep comfort, healing, and recovery.

Asia

- Join us in Prayer for the Samaritan Home project in Nagaland, India.
- Pray that the 10 girls currently enrolled may be equipped for all-around holistic development as the program continues through the year.
