Week of June 8

Europe

- Since March, a missionary working with Xiaodan and Philipp in Marburg has been hosting a weekly German Bible reading group at her home with two to three non-believing Chinese women. They read passages from the Bible and improve their German in the process.
- Pray that beyond language learning, deep conversations and interest about faith will emerge.

North America

- Pray for the National Active in Mission initiative, which will help Canadian Baptists get active and raise awareness about food security in Canada and around the world through CBM's partners. We've set a goal of raising \$100,000- half of which will stay in Canada and half of which will go toward global programming.

MENA

- Please pray for our partners in Sudan. The humanitarian situation has only worsened as war rages on. Famine has been declared in multiple locations, and food insecurity is expected to double over the next few months.
- Please pray for wisdom and provision as local churches seek to meet needs despite insecurity and logistical challenges.

Latin America and Caribbean
